INSTRUMENTAL PROGRAM- GENERAL IMFORMATION

Lessons:

- 30 minute group lesson, once weekly, on Wednesdays
- During regular school hours; students will be pulled out of a different class each week on a rotating schedule. *Students receiving RTI services will not be pulled out of the subject area classes for which they receive services*.

The signed permission form is due to the office by Friday 10/25.

Lessons will begin Wednesday, October 30th

Expectations:

In order to become successful at their instrument, it is imperative that your student practices. This will not only ensure success from the beginning, but will help the difficult task of learning an instrument be more enjoyable. Setting up a daily practice routine with a **minimum of ten minutes** will help practicing become part of the routine. A commitment to practicing is mandatory for your student's enrollment in music lessons.

Cost:

The cost for lessons for the 2019-2020 school year is \$240 total (\$30 monthly) which will be charged through your student's monthly FACTS account, with their tuition payment, for your convenience. Payments will begin with your November billing cycle.

Make-up Lesson Policy:

Students occasionally miss lessons due to absence from school, appointments scheduled during school, or a test during the class the student would be missing.

- Missed lessons that are not made up will not be reimbursed by Nazareth Elementary.
- At Nazareth Elementary we teach students personal responsibility. Lessons missed because a student forgot the lesson or comes unprepared will not be made up.

Shoulder instruments (violin and viola) will also need a shoulder rest of some sort. Please inquire about a sponge for your student when you go to rent.

Cellos are NOT allowed on the buses. Please consider this when your student makes their final decision.

While tempting, DO NOT purchase an instrument from EBay, Amazon, or any other online store. These instruments are cheap for a reason. You student will have a difficult time learning to play it and a poorly set-up instrument will ultimately hinder their progress.

If you have an instrument at home that you think would be usable, please let us see it first to confirm that it is functioning properly.

Lesson Books:

All students will need to purchase a lesson book, but not immediately. Books cost about \$10.00 and once needed, we will let you know where and how they can be purchased.
