- ► Guidelines from the Nurse's Office to be sent to all parents
- ▶ Procedures for sending sick children home – also to be sent to parents

#### **Enrollment**

- ► PK Combination, age-appropriate lessons and activities
- ► Split Grade 2 can take more students
- ► No class larger than 18 most running 12-16

#### **How to Help Prepare Children at Home**

- ► Talk about how school will look
- Start adjusting bedtimes
  - begin going to bed earlier each night



- begin getting up earlier each day
- ► Wear a mask around the house for practice even short amounts of time
- ► VIDEO to come week of Sept. 1 children will be able to see their rooms before they arrive

#### **Opening Days**



#### ▶ Phase in:

- Wednesday, September 9 ½ of every class K-6 and all in PK4 – full day
- Thursday, September 10 other ½ of each class K-6 and all in PK3 – full day
- Friday, September 11 all students full day
- > Easing the students back in will be easier:
  - Less overwhelming for students; teachers can give each child more attention
  - New procedures can be practiced with smaller group
- > Siblings will be assigned to the same day
